I. Call to Order and Welcome

President Danita Boettner called the meeting to order at 11:15 a.m.

II. Approval of November 9, 2011 Membership and Officers Meeting, and Approval of December 9, 2011 Annual Meeting Minutes *

III. Approval of Treasurer's Report *

Charles Fiedler, Treasurer, reviewed the December 31, 2011 Balance Sheet and the Actual to Proposed Budget Summary Report as follows:
