I. Call to Order and Welcome

President David Robinson called the meeting to order at 11:11 a.m.

II. Approval of January 14, 2014 Membership and Officers Meeting Minutes *

III. Approval of January 31, 2014 Treasurer's Reports *

The Actual to Budget Summary and Balance Sheet reports for December 31, 2013, were presented for review by Travis Apodaca, Treasurer, with the ending balances as follows:

IV. Old/Other Business

A. 2014 SWANA/NMRC Conference Planning Update

Terry Nelson Conference Co-Chair reported:

- **1.** Sarah Pierpont, Deputy Director of NMRC, is working on a combined package for Crossover Sponsors of which there are eighteen. Both NM SWANA and NMRC will approach these potential sponsors.
- **2.** The sponsors that are exclusively involved in the recycling industry will be approached only by NMRC.

B. 2014 NMED Special Meeting

Jerry Kamienicki distributed a sheet of SWANA eLearning Options for the May 20 and August 19, 2014 eTraining Sessions. It was decided that option two should be utilized for these two events. SWANA eLearning offers 44 eSessions at \$115.00 each.
